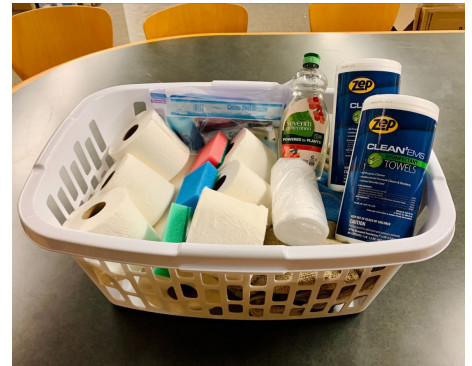


## Metro Inn Fire Victims Needs List

### Accepted Items

- **Bedding** (new or excellent condition, clean and labeled sheets so volunteers know what bedding size it will fit)
- **Pillows, Blankets, Sheet Sets (all sizes), Air Mattresses with pumps**
